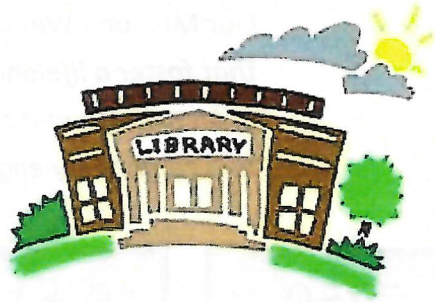

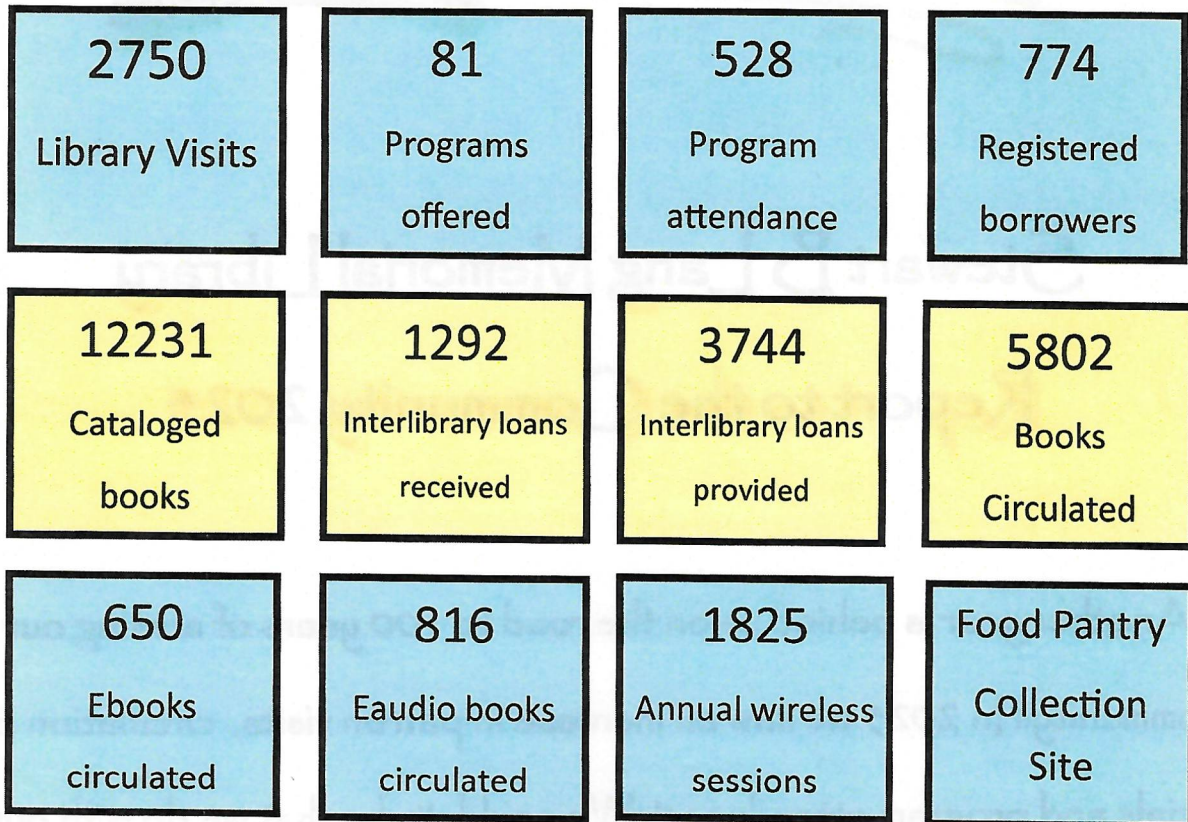
Stewart B Lang Memorial Library Report to the Community 2025
